Néstor S. Ambruso Tótaró is a native from Argentina who obtained a Master of Architecture degree from the School of Architecture at the University of Buenos Aires in 1962 and a Bachelor of Arts and Sciences from the National College of Buenos Aires in 1960.

In 1964, Mr. Ambruso moved to the United States to work for designers and contractors in the states of California and Florida. After establishing permanent residence in Puerto Rico in the late sixties, Néstor worked for several high-profile architectural firms in the capital city of San Juan.

Néstor S. Ambruso joined Ray Engineers, PSC in 1985 where he became involved with design development and construction observation for large hotel renovations and with federally-funded public projects for the Government of Puerto Rico.

In 1993, Néstor obtained his certification as specification writer and since then has aggressively promoted CSI's

certification programs among his peers and in the local construction industry in the island of Puerto Rico.

As chief specifications writer for Ray Engineers, PSC, Mr. Ambruso has been responsible for implementing a culture of systematic research and methodology for writing specifications and contract documents based on the CSI principles and practices.

Among Mr. Ambruso's leadership efforts as a CSI member he personally spearheaded the redevelopment of the Puerto Rico Chapter where he held the president's chair from 2000 to 2003. He also headed the efforts toward the establishment of the first Student Affiliate of the South East Region at the University of Puerto Rico's School of Architecture.

Néstor S. Ambruso loves to expand his cultural and geographical horizons and as a savvy traveler has visited dozens of countries around the world.
