


Gordon E. Bosl^{*}, FCSI

GORDON E. BOSL was a resident of Albuquerque, New Mexico. A licensed architect in the state of New Mexico, he received his Bachelor of Arts in Architecture from the University of Wisconsin, 1951 and became a Certified Construction Specifier in 1978.

Bosl served his chapter as president, as chairman and member of a number of committees, as delegate to region conferences and Institute conventions, and as lecturer in chapter continuing education courses.

On the Region level he was a speaker and technical chairman.

At the Institute level he was a participating member and chairman of the Technical Documents Committee, chairman of the Ad Hoc Committee, Construction Data System, member of the Jury of Fellows, Long-Range Planning Committee and Certification Committee.

He received numerous awards at the chapter, region and Institute levels and from other construction related organizations for his professional work and efforts in service for CSI.

The Southwest Region, CSI, offers the Gordon E. Bosl Award for Excellence in Construction Documents to design firms that produce "an excellent set of construction documents consisting of a project manual, drawings and addenda that were used to construct a building, engineering project or other type of construction." This award is somewhat unusual, in that only prime contractors are allowed to submit nominations, and neither the contractor nor the nominee is required to be a CSI member.

Gordon passed away in 1962.
