LARRY BROOKS was born in San Antonio, Texas in 1935. After graduating in 1959 from the University of Texas with BS and MS degrees in architectural engineering, he was employed as a field engineer in Fort Worth, Texas, and as a staff engineer in Austin, Texas, for a trade association of clay brick and tile manufacturers.

In 1964 he took a position as engineer for a precast/pre-stressed concrete company in Amarillo, Texas. In 1993, he started his own one-person consulting structural engineering office. He became a registered professional engineer in 1965, and in Oklahoma in 2006.

Brooks first joined CSI as a member of the Dallas Chapter in 1961, while employed in Fort Worth. In 1962, he helped charter the Fort Worth Chapter. Later that year, his company transferred him to Austin, where he became a member of the Austin Chapter. In 1967, he helped charter the Amarillo Chapter.

In 1988, he was elected to a one-year term as Institute vice president. He has served on the Institute Nominating Committee, the Jury of Fellows, and the Education Committee.

Brooks became a Member Emeritus in 2006, and currently serves as Membership Chair for the South Central Region.
