

# Dell R. Ewing, FCSI

DELL R. EWING was born in Buffalo, New York in 1926. He entered the navy in 1944 immediately following high school, serving until 1946 in the Pacific Theater.

He entered Bowling Green University in Ohio in 1947 and graduated with a BS degree in Marketing and Finance in 1951. He did Graduate Study in Advanced Administrative Management at George Washington University, 1961.

Upon graduation he secured a position with National Gypsum Co. in Buffalo, During a career of seven-plus years he covered several territories in Northeastern New York State, culminating in the District Office in Albany. In 1960, he relocated his family to Vienna, VA, representing Inland Steel Co. Eight years later he started and incorporated his own company. At present he has two corporations representing construction product manufacturers as independent agents.

Dell joined CSI in 1966. He was a founding member of both the Central Virginia Chapter and the Northern Virginia Chapter, and at present is a member of the DC Metropolitan Chapter, the Baltimore Chapter and the Northern Virginia Chapter.

He was elected Institute Director for the Middle Atlantic Region from FY 1985 to 1988 and became the first President of the Middle Atlantic Region during incorporation of the Region. In the 1980s he established the Region's News Letter, opening a line of communication for all CSI members and spearheaded a committee to revise the Middle Atlantic Region Administrative Guide which has been used successfully to charter two chapters.

He earned his CDT Certification the first time it was offered by the Institute, served on the Institute Certification committee to prepare the first CCPR examination and received his CCPR Certification the first time it was offered.

He served on the Committee to celebrate the 25th anniversary in D. C. and is currently on the Committee for the 50th Anniversary in Baltimore, MD in 1998.

His reputation has earned him a seat on numerous industry Committees, including AIA's Specifications Futures Committee and the NIBS Asbestos Task Force Committee.
