JOHN C. FLECK was born in 1925 in Indianapolis, Indiana. He entered the Army Air Corps in 1943 and served as a pilot until October 1945. After leaving the service, John studied pre-engineering and architecture at Purdue and the Universities of Illinois and Colorado. He continued to fly, maintaining commercial, multi-engine and instrument ratings until 2004.

After working in Oklahoma, Fleck returned to Indiana and opened his own architectural firm. In 1986 he became Executive Director of the Indiana State Office Building Commission.

Fleck was one of the seven founders of the Indianapolis CSI Chapter and served as its founding President from 1961 through 1962. He has also served the Chapter in many other capacities since.

In 1968 he was elected to the Institute Board of Directors, and served a three-year term. In 1972 he was elected Institute Vice-President, and was elected Institute President the following year.

John served as the State of Indiana as Public Works Director in 1984, and as the Executive Director of Indiana State Office Building Commission from 1984 to 1994, where he provided direction and guidance over the span of two administrations for many projects, including the Government complex, State Capital restoration, and two major parking structures. He was named to the Council of Sagamore of the Wabash, the highest personal honor an Indiana governor can bestow, by Governor Robert Orr in 1988.

John was active in all aspects of the construction industry, and received awards from many organizations other than CSI.

Fleck passed away 10 July 2013, in Indianapolis, Indiana.
