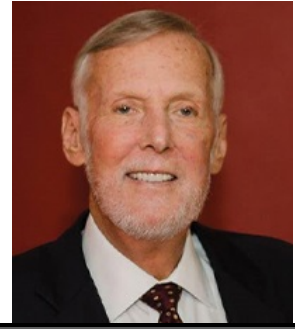


Michael F. Gibbons*, FCSI

MICHAEL F. GIBBONS was born in 1941 in Warren, Ohio. He earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Public Affairs from the U.S. Air Force Academy in 1963. Upon graduating, Michael entered the US Air Force and served as an Instructor Pilot and Flight Examiner. He later went on to earn an MBA from Southern Methodist University in 1973.

After joining the Dallas Chapter of CSI in March of 1975, Michael also became a member of the Ft. Worth, Houston, Austin, and San Antonio Chapters. He became a CCPR in 1993, and a CCCA in 2008. While he was chairman of the CCPR Task Team, that group produced the PR Module of the Manual of Practice.

Gibbons and Jim Whitfield, FCSI founded and co-chaired the first several Product Rep Academies held by CSI. He continues to instruct at those Academies.

In 1977, Gibbons started Architectural Systems, Inc., an independent manufacturers' representative firm, and he remains the president of that firm.

Michael has served on the Dallas AGC's Board of Directors, the AIA/AGC Liaison Committee, AGC Industry Relations Committee, and the North Lake College's Construction Technology and Construction Management & Technology Advisory Committee.

Michael has been a Member of the Third Congressional District's Academy Selection Board, President of Dallas Chapter of Juvenile Diabetes Foundation, President of North Texas Association of Air Force Academy Graduates, Athletic Director of North Texas Association of Air Force Academy Graduates, and Class Representative of North Texas Association of Air Force Academy Graduates.

Gibbons also has been active in ASTM since 1999, when he became a member of the E60 Committee on Sustainability. He chairs the ASTM Green Roof Task Group.

In 2010, Gibbons founded GreenRoof Consulting LLC and serves as its president.

Michael passed away 15 August 2017.
