SANDRA A. HUNDLEY is an architect and owner of her own architectural firm in Sewickley, PA. Immediately after passing the new Certified Construction Specifier (CCS) exam, she joined the Pittsburgh Chapter CSI in 1981. Within a few years she was actively serving on chapter committees and the board, moving up to president in 1991 and 1992. During her leadership as president, she strengthened the chapter by accomplishing her four goals: (1) increase chapter membership, (2) get more members involved in committees, (3) develop new ideas for the chapter product show, and (4) increase the monthly meeting attendance. The chapter grew to 238 members, which historically is the highest membership to date.

At the encouragement of chapter and region members, Sandra became active in the Middle Atlantic Region, Leadership conferences and region conferences, serving on several committees and programs. She believes that her most important contribution to the region was in 1992, establishing the third highest region award, the George C. Neuhausel

Memorial Award, which honors those who have been members for 15 years or more, actively serving on committees and participating in all chapter, region and Institute events, but have not received any of the top three region awards. She also co-chaired the 1995 MA region conference and chaired the region awards committee in her third year.

As chair in her third year on the Institute Specifications Competition Committee, she led the committee in developing a new entry category for manufacturers product binders and literature for the FY 1996 competition. She also served on the Jury of Fellows committee and chaired the Membership Committee in her third year.

Although Sandra will continue to serve on all levels of CSI and enjoys all of the wonderful friendships she has made during the past 21 years, the greatest reward was being advanced to Fellow of the Institute in June, 2002 in Las Vegas, NV.
