JACK KLEMEYER was born at San Francisco in 1945. He attended public schools in Lodi and, in 1963, entered Cornell University's College of Architecture, Art, and Planning in Ithaca, New York. He graduated with a B.Arch in 1968 and an MS in Architecture in 1970.

He returned to San Francisco after Cornell, and worked for Wertheim & van der Ploeg until January of 1973 when he accepted a teaching appointment at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Zurich. A year later he returned to San Francisco and joined the newly created firm of Wertheim, van der Ploeg, & Klemeyer, a practice involving architecture, landscape architecture, and planning.

His involvement in CSI began in August of 1977 with the San Francisco Chapter. He has been an active member at Chapter, Region, and Institute levels at various times, serving

among other things as West Region Treasurer, as Chairman of the 1994 Convention Committee, and as a member of the Institute Finance, Awards, and Technical Committees.

As part of the United Nations programs, he delivered a lecture in Harbin, China, covering the preparation of construction documents in the United States. Through the efforts of Walter Geisinger and the generosity of CSI, he was able to provide the Harbin Architectural and Engineering Institute with a complete set of SpecText guide specifications and a wealth of other material developed by CSI, for which both students and staff were very grateful.

Klemeyer is a registered architect in California, Illinois, and Michigan, and holds an NCARB certificate. His firm has an active practice covering projects throughout the United States and Europe.
