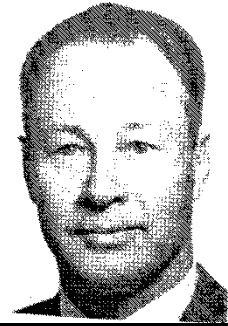


Ralph G. Lane, FCSI

RALPH G. LANE was born in Des Moines, Iowa in 1911. He attended Drake and Grinnell Universities, graduating with a BA in 1935.
