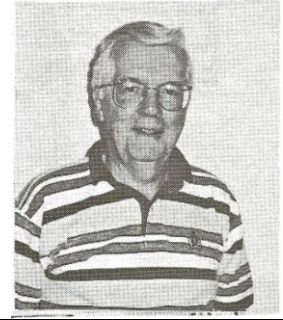


Charles E. McGuire, FCSI

CHARLES E. MCGUIRE was born in 1923 in Indianapolis, Indiana. After three years service with the Army Air Forces in World War II, he attended the University of Notre Dame and graduated in 1949 with a Bachelor of Architecture Degree.

Following three years with the American Embassy in Brussels, Belgium, McGuire worked as project architect with firms in Plymouth, Indiana, Lake Charles, Louisiana, and Houston, Texas. Returning to Indianapolis he was the specifications writer for WPL, Architects, then for Fleck, Burkart, Shropshire, and for James Associates.

In 1979 McGuire left Indianapolis and moved to St. Louis Missouri to become Head of Specifications for HBE Corporation, the largest design/build firm in the United States specializing in the design and construction of hospitals and banking facilities. He joined the St. Louis Chapter of CSI and served for five years as its Technical Documents Chairman. Repeating his success in St. Louis, the St. Louis Chapter received the Institute Chapter Technical Excellence Award in 1982, during his service as chairman of the Technical Committee.

In 1988, he returned to Indianapolis where he practices as an independent specifications consultant with his brother, as McGuire Architects, Inc.

Over the years McGuire has authored or updated over 100 Technical Documents for CSI. These documents range from

Guide Specifications and Technical Aid Series Documents to Monographs.

In 1973 McGuire served the Great Lakes Region as Chairman of the Region Technical Committee. The two previous years he had received the Region Birchfield-Tyler Honor Award in its annual Specification Competition.

McGuire first served the Institute as a member of the Technical Document Committee from 1973 to 1975. In 1980, he was appointed to chair the Specification Competition Committee. In 1984 he was appointed to the Jury of Fellows and after two years became its chairman.

McGuire is known for the excellence of the specifications he authors. He has received awards in the annual specification competition on many occasions including a first place award in 1971, he was also presented the Ben John Small award for excellence in specification writing 1974, and Technical Commendations in 1971, 1977, and 1982.

In 1973 McGuire served the Great Lakes Region as Chairman of the Region Technical Committee

In 1988, he returned to Indianapolis where he practices as an independent specifications consultant with his brother, as McGuire Architects, Inc.
